

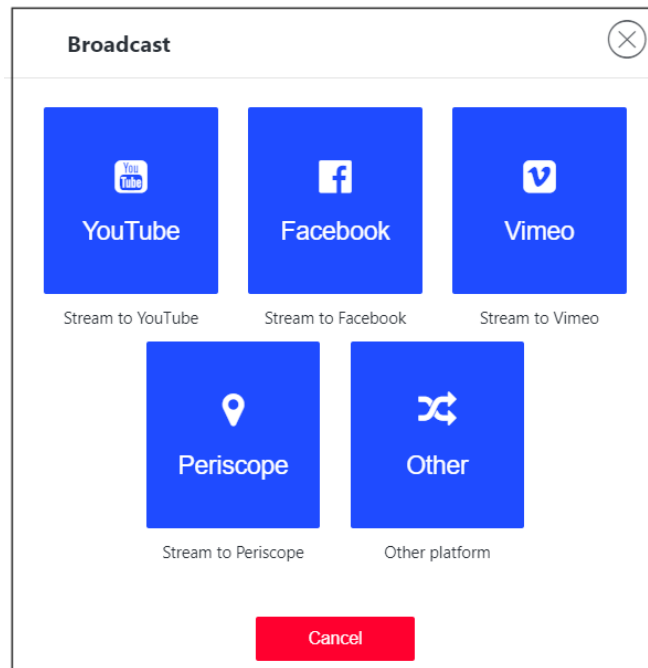


BROADCASTING TO SOCIAL MEDIA

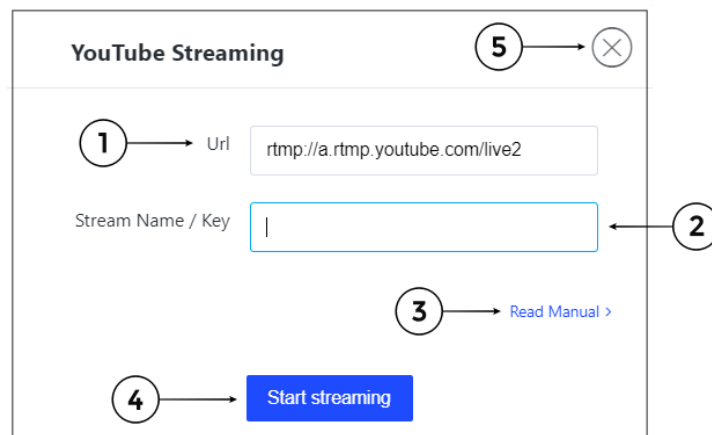


Description

Streaming is available for YT, Facebook, Vimeo, Periscope and any other platform if you only provide its streaming URL and stream name or key.



How to stream to YouTube



1. **URL** - here you need to provide the YouTube streaming URL, which can be found in the “**Encoder Setup**” in your YouTube Live options.
2. **Stream Name/Key** - here you need to provide the YouTube stream name/key, which can be found under the “**Encoder Setup**” option. To obtain this code, under the “**YouTube Live**” menu click “**Stream Now Classic**”. You will be redirected to your live stream dashboard, from there simply scroll down to “**Encoder Setup**”. Copy URL and

Stream Name/Key codes from YouTube and paste them into the (2) “**Stream Name/Key**” box in LiveWebinar.

How to stream to Facebook

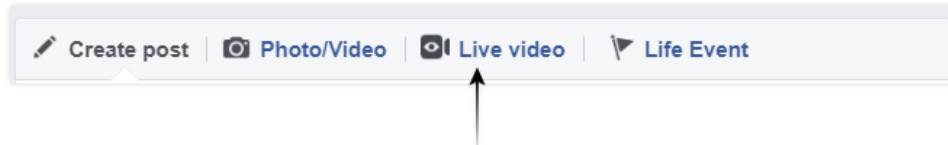

5. **“Close” button** – click it to close this window.

How to get FB streaming URL and key


1. Log into your FB account - you need to use Google Chrome browser (only Chrome FB shows that option).
2. Navigate to your general profile and click "**Live Video**" in the upper menu.



3. Click on the "**Live Video Setup**" tab, and then click on "**Stream Setup**". Once there, select "**Use Stream Key**".

4. Scroll down and copy the Server URL and Stream Key shown below and paste them into the matching fields inside the LiveWebinar meeting room. Then, click the "**Start Streaming**" (4) button.



- Return to the browser tab that has Facebook live running, and then click the **"Go Live"** button in the bottom-left corner.



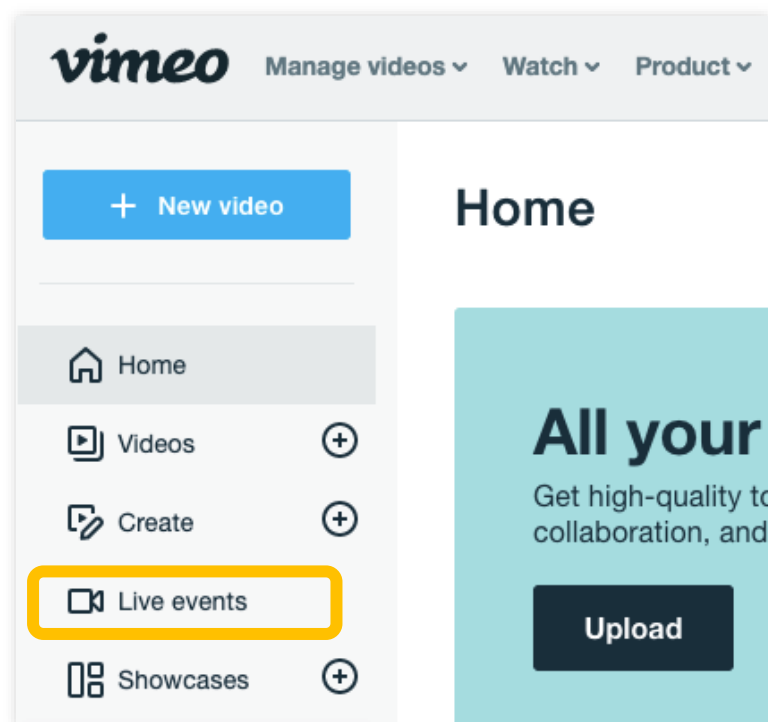

How to stream to Vimeo

1. **URL** - here you need to provide Vimeo streaming URL (RTMP URL). Simply copy and paste the code from your Vimeo account. Read in the next step where to find this URL.
2. **Stream Name/Key** - Here you need to provide Vimeo Stream Name/Key, copy and paste the code from Vimeo. The URL and Stream Name/Key are highlighted in the screenshot below – to find them simply go to “**Live Events**” from your home page and click on the “**Connect (RTMP)**” window.



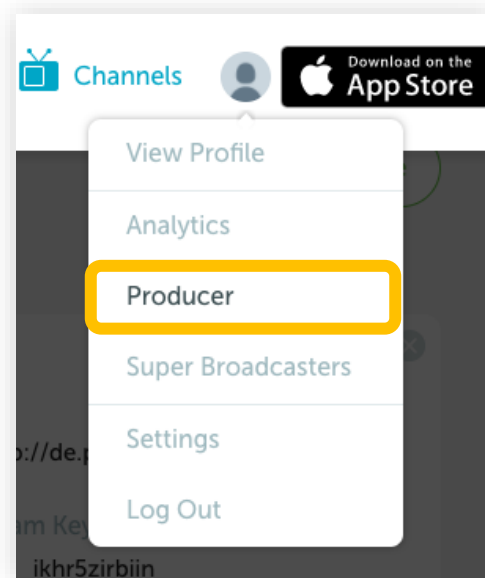
3. Paste the Stream URL and Key into the required areas in the LiveWebinar meeting room and click on (3) **“Start streaming”** button
4. Close window (4) and begin your webinar.

How to stream to Periscope

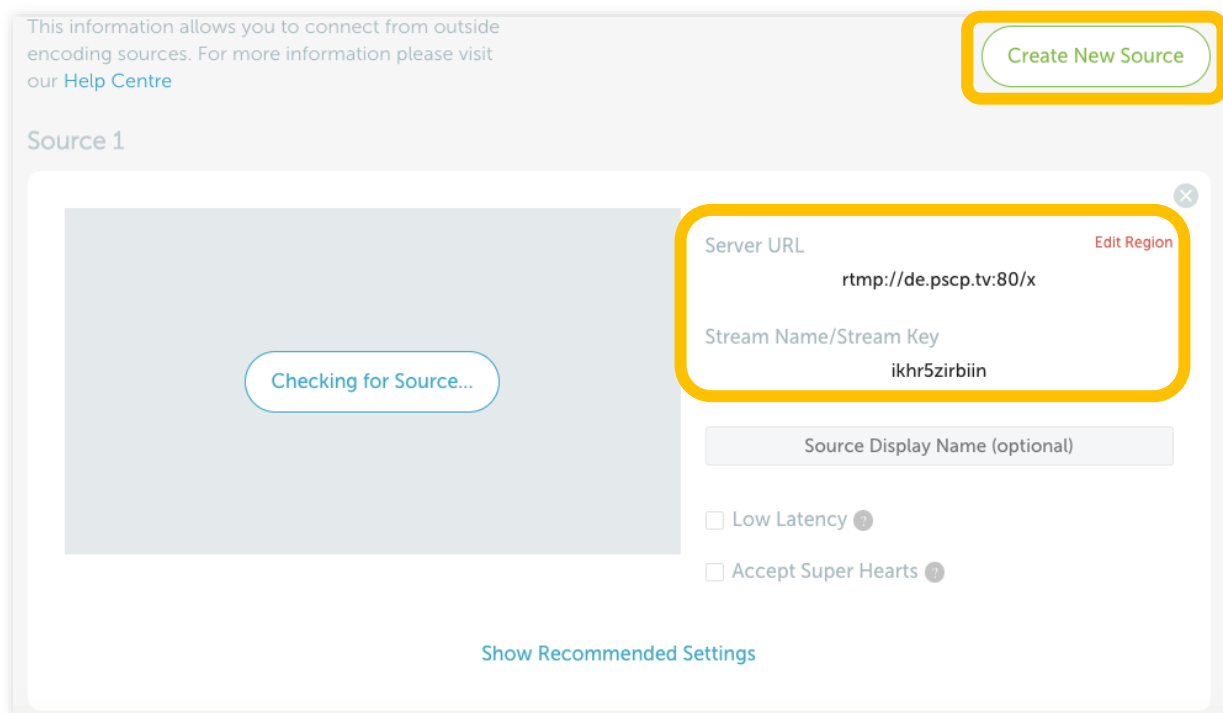
1. **URL** - here you need to provide Periscope streaming URL
2. **Stream Name/Key** - here you need to provide Periscope Stream Name or Key
3. **“Start streaming”** button – click it when you fill out fields above
4. **“Close” button** – click it to close the window

How to get Periscope streaming URL and key:

1. Go to your Periscope account and open profile menu. Then choose “**Producer**”



2. Click “**Create a new source**” and copy the **Server URL** and **Stream Name/Key**.



3. Go back to the meeting Room and Paste **Server URL** and **Stream Name/Stream Key** into the matching fields.
4. Click “**Start Streaming**” button, close the window and begin your webinar.
